Benton County Finance Committee Minutes August 22, 2023

Ken Spencer called the Benton County Finance meeting to order on August 22, 2023, at 11:01 a.m.

Present Treasurer Ken Spencer, Auditor Brenda Chilton, and Commissioner Will McKay (remote). Also present were county staff members, Heather Hutchison, Jeanette Ulrick, Kirsten Yniguez of the Treasurer's Office, and Lorene Roe of the Auditor's Office

Approval of the Minutes

Brenda moved to approve the 2023 1st quarter minutes. Will seconded and minutes were approved.

Heather presented the 2nd Quarter, 2023, Analysis:

The 2nd quarter ending 06/30/2023 had a portfolio balance of \$409,102,287.71.

2nd quarter portfolio activity for the Treasurer's Investment Pool (TIP) included purchases of \$38,690,410.40 and maturities of (\$15,952,403.33).

3rd Quarter Strategy

- Continue bi-weekly FHN Financial conference calls and internal discussions.
- Invest in securities according to the policy; being aware of the current market conditions for upcoming maturities and discuss with FHN for reinvesting while being aware of the benchmark.
- During 2nd quarter, meetings were held with the districts. The County stressed the importance of updated cash flows for the portfolio and will continue to work diligently to ensure cash flows remain updated.

Discussion

Ken explained that during the district meetings, it was emphasized that the more information we receive about their needs, the better we can be prepared to accommodate those needs. Selling bonds for cash needs prior to their maturity is not ideal and creates a loss.

Approval of Minutes

Currently the County has 120 million invested with very low rates and the trend currently is to keep more liquidity.

Farm credit continues to be better than housing credit.

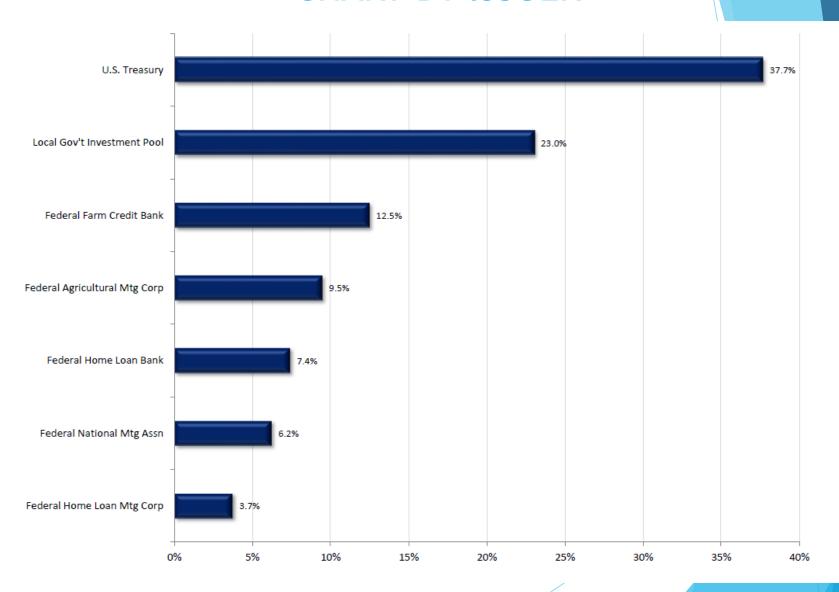
